Unidos en Misión México is a **missions sending agency** legally established in Mexico City since 2018.





“I've been sent by Unidos en Mision Mexico. My ministry consists of translating the Word into the local language of a remote indigenous group in Asia. Part of this involves traveling between 10-14 hours to a community where I share with them, learn and analyze their language, and build relationships with the local people.

This year has had its challenges, but I have also enjoyed our Father's goodness.

One of the greatest miracles was getting the legal permission to continue living in this country and learning the national language at the university, after much paperwork and uncertainty.

In my ministry, it has been wonderful to see how a friend has begun to understand the Word and memorize parts of it, delving deeper into it. Together we work to ensure that the message that will reach her people is faithful, clear, and meaningful to the community that speaks this language.

Being part of the process of seeing someone grow in God who does not yet have the Word in her own language or a community of faith has been an immense gift.

“God has been confirming my calling to missions for several years. This year’s short-term missions trip (STM) to Peru with Unidos en Misión helped me reflect on how to use my studies to serve Him. Choosing where to serve long-term is not easy nor is it something I should decide on my own. I am learning to depend on God to take the next steps in my life.

During the STM, we served at a shelter for cancer patients near a local hospital in Lima, mainly for children and senior citizens who come from remote areas of the country. We shared the Gospel through a puppet show, and it was beautiful to see the smiles on their faces. Even a child who was very affected by chemotherapy sang and danced a song called “El amor de Dios” (The Love of God) with me! It was a moment that filled my heart.

God taught me through the STM that everything I do is not for my own recognition, but so that others may see Christ. Amidst the uncertainties of an STM, including how to raise the needed financial support, what matters is your willingness to serve the Lord, that you have a heart open to learn what He wants to teach you.”



Financial Highlights


DONATIONS

Of the entire budget to sustain the ministry, **18%** came from Mexico (a **16%** increase since opening Unidos in 2018!) and **82%** came from abroad.

We thank God for His great faithfulness, sustaining power, and miraculous provision! It has been a year of much joy despite many health, economic and ministry challenges of serving in Mexico.

Among this year's blessings, we highlight:

- Mobilizing more than **400 world Christians** and participating in more than **30 conferences** and **missions events**
- Coordinating a **short-term mission trip** for **11 participants** to **Lima, Peru**
- Launching a **missionary family** to the United States, two families within Mexico, and accompanying **13 missionary candidates** in the long-term sending process to the nations
- Providing **spiritual retreats** for several missionaries, pastors, and ministry leaders
- Supporting **least-reached communities** in Mexico: the **Deaf, Chinese, and Mixtec** people
